- There is No Charge for use of chairs

### Reservations:

- Chairs are available on a first come, first served basis (609-522-8258)
- Picture ID needed to reserve a Beach Wheel Chair

## ACCESSIBLE RESTROOMS

- Accessible restrooms (boardwalk level) are located at Glenwood, Youngs, and Leaming Aves
- At Schellenger Ave (beach level), there is a ramp from boardwalk to beach and comfort station
- Accessible portable restrooms located on the beach every few blocks

## ACCESSIBLE PARKING 10AM - 6PM

- Available on at least every other street
- Accessible spaces at municipal parking lots (Rio Grande, Taylor, Leaming, Hand)
- Baker Avenue Beach Parking Lot at Baker and the Boardwalk will have accessible spaces available on the beach for 4 wheel drive vehicles

## BEACH TAXI

Operates the entire length and width of the City of Wildwood Beach. Weekend service will begin, Saturday May 23th, and daily service will begin Saturday, June 8th until Sunday September 13th. The Beach Taxi is available from 10AM- 4:30PM.

# GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR SAFE SURF CHAIR USE

- Use of the surf chair is restricted to those individuals weighing less than three hundred (300) pounds
- An attendant must be present when the chair is in use
- The attendant must not undertake tasks which exceed his/her physical ability
- At no time, and under no circumstances is the surf chair to be placed in the water beyond a depth of six inches.



## ACCESS TO BOARDWALKS, BEACHES AND PIERS

- Handicap ramps at 21st, 23rd, 24th, 25th, 26th, 27th, 29th, 30th, 32nd streets, and 8th and Avalon Avenue
- Ramps to boardwalk and beach requiring companion's assistance at 22nd Street
- Hard-packed gravel paths from street to beach are located at 9th-20th, 32nd-40th, 44th, 48th, 50th, and 57th-79th Streets
- Accessible bay-front piers at 20th & 5th Avenue, 23rd, 33rd, 37th and 57th streets and 8th Street Pier at the bayside

## SURF CHAIRS

- 9th, 30th and 80th Streets at the beach

- Dune Drive & 10th Street (Recreation Field)
- 29th Street on the Boardwalk Surfside Park
- 30th Street & the beach (Community Hall)
- Dune Drive & 31st Street outside between the Fire House & Police Station
- Dune Drive & 31st Street (Senior's Center) during hours of operation
- Dune Drive & 32nd Street (Borough Hall), during hours of operation
- 250 39th Street Tennis Courts Public Restrooms, during hours of operation

## ACCESSIBLE PARKING

- At 30th Street, adjacent to Community Hall (4 spaces on north and south sides of building)
- At 32nd Street & the boardwalk (1 space)
- Parking lot at 29th Street at the boardwalk (4 spaces)

## ACCESS TO BOARDWALKS AND BEACHES

- Ramps to the boardwalk (promenade) are located at 17 streets along Beach Drive
- Ramps from the boardwalk (promenade) to the beach at Broadway, 3rd and Cove, Grant and Gurney Streets and Trenton Ave

## SURF CHAIRS

- First Ave Beach (2 chairs)
- Stegers Beach (2 chairs)
- Stockton Street Beach (2 chairs)

### Reservations:

- Surf chairs are available (No Charge) on a first come-first served system
- A photocopy of a Driver's License is required to use the chairs
- Chairs will be delivered by the Beach Patrol
- Chairs must stay on the beach and must be returned by 4:30 pm

## ACCESSIBLE RESTROOMS

There are 7 accessible restrooms on the boardwalk (promenade) along Beach Drive. The locations are: Wilmington Avenue, Trenton Avenue, Philadelphia Avenue, Gurney Street, Grant Street, Broadway, and Second Avenue.

## ACCESSIBLE PARKING

Accessible Parking is available on Beach Drive at 2nd Street, Broadway, Grant Street, Perry Street, Decatur Street, Ocean Street, Howard Street, Jefferson Street, Madison Avenue, Trenton Avenue, Pittsburgh Avenue, Philadelphia Avenue, Wilmington Avenue, and at the Convention Center.

Handicapped persons whose motor vehicles properly display a windshield placard or special license plate are exempt from paying parking meter fees throughout the City of Cape May (Ordinance 240-2011)

## SURF CHAIRS

- Pickup (No Charge) at the Sports & Civic Center - 6th Street & the Boardwalk between 9 am and 5 pm.
- Delivery (no charge)

### Reservations:

- Reservations are encouraged; to reserve a chair, contact the Recreation Division at the Sports & Civic Center (609-525-9304) between 9 am and 5 pm
- Surf chairs can be reserved for up to 1 week or can be used on a daily basis
- Failure to pick up the chair within 24 hours of the initial reservation date will result in the cancellation of your reservation
- Both child and adult size chairs are offered

## ACCESSIBLE RESTROOMS

- Public restrooms will be located on the boardwalk at 1st Street, 6th Street, Music Pier, 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th Streets
- Public restrooms are also available at the Sports & Civic Center and at the 34th and 59th Street lifeguard stations

- Limited handicapped parking designated at most beach-block street ends.

- Ramps from street to the Promenade at 29th Street, 32nd, 33rd, 34th, 35th, 40th, 44th and 57th Street. Access to beach at, 32nd, 40th, 44th, 63rd, 85th and JFK streets
- Gazebo with picnic facilities at 85th Street entrance
- 94th Street gazebo at Townsend's Inlet Park has ramp access to the gazebo and to a decked walkway into the dunes

## SURF CHAIRS

### Locations:

- Chairs are available YEAR ROUND through the Recreation Department - 4501 Park Road 609-263-1013

### Reservations:

- Surf chairs are available (No Charge) on a first come-first served system
- 2 forms of ID are required
- Reservations are strongly suggested
- Chairs may be signed out for 1-14 days; on the first day of a reservation, the chair(s) must be picked up by 11:30 am
- If chairs are kept for more than 1 day, you must provide your own storage and transportation

## ACCESSIBLE RESTROOMS

- Public restrooms are located at 32nd, 40th, 44th, 85th on the beach and 94th Street at Townsend's Inlet Park
- All restrooms have at least 1 accessible stall
- There are separate fully accessible restrooms at 32nd and 40th Streets on the Promenade and at 85th Street at the beach

## ACCESSIBLE PARKING

- There are accessible parking spaces along JFK Boulevard & Promenade and at Townsend's Inlet Park at 94th Street
- Mostly metered parking
