and a goodie bag**

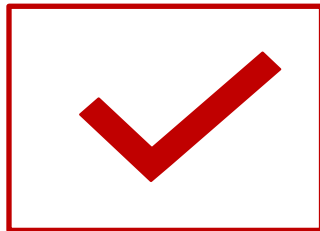
**9 Honorable Mention Winners will be honored

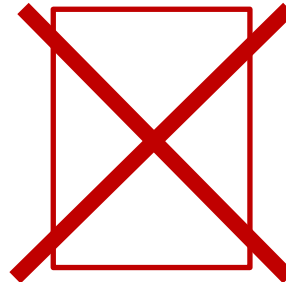
HERE ARE THE RULES:

- Design a poster to depict “What do you TREASURE about Cape May County”
- Use a standard 22" X 28" white poster board.
- CAPE MAY COUNTY must be written in 4" BLACK SOLID LETTERS ACROSS THE TOP OF THE POSTER.
- The name of the student, homeroom teacher and the name of the school must be printed neatly on the back of the poster. One entry per student.
- Do not glue any materials or three dimensional objects onto the poster.
- Special knowledge or background is not needed. The poster design and content are at the discretion of the student.
- Vibrant colors are encouraged.
- **NEW** for this year. Posters must be HORIZONTAL.
