## **Exhibitor Rules and Regulations**

Exhibitors must display, and sell only the items they submitted, and approved by the committee. Photos of work, and display submitted to the committee will not be returned. Preference will be given for original arts or crafts. Some direct sales items may be allowed if judged by the committee to be holiday related.

This event will end after sunset, therefore lighting will be limited at the courtyard of the Zoo. It is strongly suggested to bring some battery powered lighting to showcase your items best.

Once the exhibitors enter the park, they will be directed to the exhibit area, and their particular space(s). All spaces will be pre-assigned.

Set Up Times: 12 noon to 2:00 p.m., Saturday, November 25, 2023

Show Hours: 2:00 p.m. to 6:00 p.m., Saturday, November 25, 2023

Break Down Times: Early break down will not be permitted. Participants must leave their exhibit set up for the length of the show

All vehicles must be removed from the exhibit area by 1:30 p.m. In order to keep the area from getting congested, we are requesting that exhibitors drop off their display and merchandise and park their vehicle prior to setting up their display. Vehicles are not permitted on the actual courtyard during show hours for any purpose.

Exhibitors will be erecting their displays on mixed sidewalk, and grass areas. All racks, tents, canopies, and other displays must be securely weighted or staked down. All precautions should be taken to ensure safety in windy conditions. Exhibitors must furnish their own tables, and chairs.

No merchandise storage outside of exhibit booth is allowed.

There is no rain date or refunds of application fee once accepted.

Exhibitors must maintain the cleanliness, and orderliness of their booths at all times, reflecting the proper decorum of a fine show. No improper behavior, offensive language or loud music is permitted. Exhibitors must dispose of their trash in proper receptacles throughout the day.
