



Zoo Etiquette

- No outside food is permitted inside the Zoo.
- Zoo Hours 10 am – 4:45 pm (March 8- October 30, 2014)
10 am – 3:45 pm (October 31 – March 7, 2015)
- No pets are permitted in the Zoo.
- The Zoo is smoke-free for the health and happiness of all our animals and guests.
- Please do not throw objects, tap or bang on exhibit glass or enclosures.
- There are many beautiful things growing throughout our Zoo. Climbing the trees, picking flowers or disturbing the landscape is prohibited.
- Visitors may not sit, stand on or climb on exhibits, fences, railings or gardens.
- No activities which could be hazardous to other visitors or animals (ex. play fighting, playing catch).
- If someone is acting inappropriately or dangerously, they will be escorted from the Zoo. If you see someone acting in this manner, please contact a Zoo staff member.
- No feeding the animals (exceptions: the pellet food provided through the coin operated machines at the farmyard and duck ponds).
- No alcohol is permitted in the Park and Zoo.
- No bikes, roller skates, roller blades, heeled shoes, skateboards, or scooters in the Zoo.
- No balloons, large toys, or balls in the Zoo.
- Shoes and shirt are required.
- Please keep in mind: you may not see every animal listed when you visit the Zoo, and their locations are subject to change as is their desire to be inside their dens or outside for our viewing pleasure
