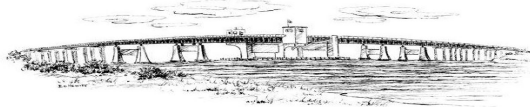

2020 Middle Thorofare Bridge Rehabilitation Construction Update*

Thursday December 24 through Tuesday January 5, 2021

- Continuing Stage I railing work on southwest side of the bridge (Lund's side).
- Continuous single lane alternating one-way traffic pattern (partial closure of the south bound lane). Vehicles can pass but expect minor delays. Tolls are being collected southbound direction.
- Thursday, 12/24 to Sunday, 1/3/2021 - No planned work within the navigation channel.
- Monday, 12/14 to Monday, 1/22/2021, **Navigation Restrictions** Monday-Friday, possibly Saturdays, 7 p.m. to 6 a.m., Contractor will have barges in the navigation channel performing fender work. Emergency vessels (33 CFR 117.31) may pass with 2 hours' notice given.
- Monday, 1/4/2021 (inclusive) - Resume overnight **bridge roadway closure** from 9pm to 5am. No vehicles can pass. Bridge will be in the open position while contractor works beneath in the navigation channel. Work beneath the bascule span to continue for about 3 weeks.
- Thursday, 12/24 10:30pm through Friday, 12/25 10:30pm, toll collector not on duty. No toll collection. Bridge openings require 2 hr. notice by calling 609-368-4591, County Office of Emergency Management.

*Schedules subject to change due to weather conditions or other factors beyond the Commission's control
