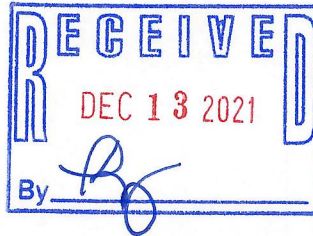

Dear Mr. Donofrio:

Coast Guard review of your proposed project as provided in a letter dated October 14, 2021, and an email dated November 18, 2021, from Ms. Rebecca Lyne with Michael Baker International, Inc., on behalf of the Cape May County Bridge Commission, is complete.

Based on the documentation provided and our research, it is determined that a Coast Guard bridge permit will not be required for the proposed project on highway drawbridge – CR 619 (Ocean Drive) Bridge, over Corson Inlet, mile 0.9, at location [39.20221, -74.655662], near Upper Township, Cape May County, NJ.

The scope and detail of work constitutes a bridge maintenance project in which a Coast Guard bridge permit is not required in accordance with Title 33 Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) §115.40 (Bridge Repairs).

Please submit a bridge maintenance project plan at least 30 days (preferably 90 days) prior to commencement of work on or over the waterway. Upon review and acceptance of the bridge maintenance project plan, the Coast Guard will publish a local notice to mariners and forward a letter of acceptance to the bridge owner.

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The fact that a Coast Guard bridge permit is not required does not relieve you of the responsibility for compliance with the requirements of any other Federal, State, or local agency who may have jurisdiction over any aspect of the project.
